Meeting Minutes: June 17th, 2020

In Attendance:

RaeAnn Shoemaker called the meeting to order.

Raeanne Reid made a motion to approve the May 13th minutes. The motion was seconded by Dusty Childress. All approved.

Election of Officers:

Max Meckem made a motion for Raeanne Reid to continue as Park Board Vice President. The motion was seconded by Bob Mowery. All approved.

Dusty Childress made a motion for Carrie Plassmeyer to continue as Park Board Secretary. The motion was seconded by Raeanne Reid. All approved.

Kids Fishing Day

John Shelton reported that the event took place last Saturday and that around 100 kids participated in the event. Each kid received a fishing pole, a shirt, and other fishing gear that sponsors had donated to the event. He did mention that due to COVID-19 the Missouri Department of Conservation couldn't participate this year but they did purchase fish to stock the pond.

Baseball Tournament Update:

Elliot Wilburn reported that so far, they have hosted 4 baseball tournaments with the smallest tournament having 44 teams and the most having 58 teams. He said that all 10 fields in town are being used during these tournaments and they are drawing a lot of out of town teams. There are 3 more tournaments on the schedule to take place this year.

Boswell Aquatic Center Update:

Elliot reported that attendance has been great so far this year and is up over last years numbers. He also reported that they would be offering swim lessons and lifeguard certifications.

Movies in the Park:

Elliot stated that they are partnering with LifePoint church to show 3 movies in the park in August and that they are also working on dates for Kiwanis to have a movie in the park as well.

Gasconade River Bridge:

John stated that the Route 66 committee would like to get a piece of the Gasconade River Bridge to put in Boswell Park, and set up a kiosk with information about the bridge. John thinks it would be a nice piece of history and another attraction to get people to the park.


Comments from the Board:
