



Reopening Guidance - Phase I for Outfitters / Campgrounds / Lodging

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Missourians shall abide by the 6-foot distancing rule from other individuals. This does not apply to family members or individuals performing job duties that require contact with other people to perform their work duties.

Enhanced precautions should be taken when work duties require contact with people less than 6 feet apart.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Citizens who feel sick should stay home.
- Continue to practice good hygiene.
- Avoid socializing in groups that do not allow for appropriate physical distancing.
- When in public, maximize physical distancing from others.
- Minimize travel to the extent possible.

Outfitters, Campgrounds and other similar establishments are permitted to reopen, but are cautioned to implement adjustments to reduce the risk of contracting and/or spreading COVID-19 between employees and patrons. The following is recommended guidance for these establishments:

- Temperature screening of all employees at the beginning of each shift, along with assessment for COVID-19 symptoms, including those in the employee household.
- Employees and patrons are encouraged to wear masks, especially in enclosed spaces.
- Establishments with store/office should follow the building occupancy code guidance as detailed in the Show-Me Strong Recovery Plan: Phase I.
- Require 6-foot social distancing between patrons (non-family). This includes check-in/check-out, and all provided activities.
- Do not allow congregating of groups (non-family). Families are permitted to gather at their own campsite, but should not gather with other individuals/families.
- Tables and seating for dine-in food/drink areas shall be spaced according to social distance requirements. Ensure 6-foot distance between each table. No more than 10 people per table.
- All shared recreational equipment (e.g.: Canoes, Kayaks, Paddles, Fishing Poles/Equipment, Life Vests, Tubes/Floats, etc.) must be sanitized between every use.
- Any transportation provided must comply with social distancing guidelines and individuals not part of the same household must be 6-feet apart, this includes staff. Vehicles used for transport must be thoroughly sanitized between every transport. Increase ventilation is encouraged (open windows).
- Pools provided should be maintained with adequate sanitizing and chlorination processes.
- Employees must perform hand hygiene (hand washing or hand sanitizer) between interactions of each patron.
- Require hand washing of patrons upon entering establishment.
- Cleaning and sanitizing of all tables, chairs, door handles, floors, restrooms, and any other high-touch surfaces must be performed multiple times throughout each workday. Ensure proper concentration and contact time of sanitizer.
- If applicable, encourage contactless and/or non-signature of check-in and/or payments. If not possible, check-in and payment stations must be sanitized between each client use.
