
Median household income is **\$15.6K below** the national median household income of \$62.8K.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 1.1%** since 2015, growing by 389. Population is expected to **increase by 1.5%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 523.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **increased by 1.4%** in Laclede County, MO from 14,663 to **14,873**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 0.0% by 1.4%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 73.0% to 74.8% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.4% of Laclede County, MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.6% below the national average), and **8.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Ship and Boat Building, Ventilation, Heating, Air-Conditioning, and Commercial Refrigeration Equipment Manufacturing, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.









Unemployment by Gender











Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

Laclede County, MO had a June 2021 unemployment rate of 4.61%, **decreasing from 5.45% 5 years before**.






Millennials

Laclede County, MO has 6,356 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 7,397.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Laclede County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 10,683 people 55 or older, while there are 11,571 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Laclede County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 14,458 racially diverse people, while there are 2,570 here.




Veterans

Laclede County, MO has 3.01 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime







Top Growing Industries




Top Industry LQ












Top Occupation Earnings


● 2020 Median Hourly Earnings


